NETRA PARISHEK KRIYAKALPA IN NETRA ROGA -A LITERATURE REVIEW

Ayurveda is one of the oldest medical science in the world. It says Sarvendriyanam Nayanam Pradhanam. Acharya Sushruta advocated Kriyakalpa is the main therapeutic procedure of Netra Rogas, along with other forms of treatment. He has described this in a separate chapter in Uttartantra of Sushrut Samhita i.e Tarpan, Putpaka, Aschyotan, Parishek, Anjana. Parishek is one of important Kriyakalpa. It includes pouring of medicated liquids on closed eye lids in a thin and continuous stream from 4" height for a specific time according to dosha. Netra Parishek is one such aspect which not only maintains health status of eye but also prevents pathogenesis of many Netra *Rogas.* So it is important to review the description available in the

Ayurvedic text related with Netra Parishek. This article is focusing on Netra Parishek Kriya Kalpa in Netra Roga.

INTRODUCTION

The importance of *Netra* in all sense organs is quoted in Ayurveda by "Sarvendriyanam" madhye naynasya pradhanatavata^[1]. Shalakya tantra is one among eight specialities of Ashtang Ayurveda which deals with Urdhwajatrugat vyadhis. [2] In Ayurved Samhita Acharyas has quoted many Kriyakalpa yogas for eyes rather than internal medication. Acharya Sushruta mentioned five kriya kalpa i.e Tarpana, Putpaka, Seka, Aschyotan, and Anjana. [3] Acharya Sharangdhar mentioned 7 Kriya Kalpa five of them are same as Sushrut and added Pindi and Bidalaka to them.

Kriyakalpa is the main therapeutic process for ophthalmology in *Shalakya tantra*. The word *Kriyakalpa* built from two words *Kriya* and *Kalpa*. *Kriya* means therapeutic procedure used to cure disease and *Kalpa* means practicable, possible, manner of acting, a prescribed rule.

Parishek is important kriya Kalpa in Netraroga chikitsa, so it is essential to review the literature regarding the Prishek.

Defination:- *Parishek* is a *Kriyakalpa* in which medicated liquid is poured on closed eyelid continuously from 4" height for specific time according to *doshas*. [4]

It is widely used method in eye diseases involving inflammation, pain, redness, burning like symptoms.

To understand the concept of *Parishek Kriyakalpa* in *Netrarogas*.

MATERIAL

Parishek common drugs^[7]

1. Vatadushti - Tikta, Snigdha dravya

2. Pittadushti/Raktadushti - Madhur, Sheet dravya

3. Kaphadushti - Tikta, Ushna, Ruksha

4. Sheet Ritu - Koshna dravya

5. Ushna Ritu - Sheet dravya

In our classics *pichu* (swab), *varti* (wick)^[8] have been mentioned but practically a stainless steel glass, bowl, kundi etc used for *Parishek*.

METHOD

Lie patient in supine position. Medicated liquids are poured on closed eye lids in a thin and

continuous stream from 4" height for a specific time, according to *dosha*. After the treatment eyes should be washed or cleaned with lukewarm water and advised not to see the bright things and not to take *kapha vriddhikar ahara* and *vihara*. [9]

It is indicated in acute conditions like burning sensation of eyes, dry eyes, watery eyes, itchy eyes, conjunctivitis, foreign body sensation in eye.

DISCUSSION

Mode of action of netra parishek

As medicine is poured over the eyelids continuously for a specific time, it absorbed through skin of lids and helps to improve the circulation locally thereby reduces the inflammation and strengthens the muscles, nerves of eyes.^[13]

- 2. Swabhavik Varna(getting natural colour to eyes)
- 3. *Karya Padutwam*(perfectness in the function of the part)
- 4. *Vedhana Shanti*(relief from pain etc)

Netra Parishek is one of the important *Kriya Kalpa*, which has been used since thousands of years. It gives remarkable effect of the drugs locally and gives complete relief in the local signs and symptoms of the disease.
