Kesh and **Nakha** are **Malas** of **Asthidhatu**^[1]

Kesh and nakha are develops during formation of asthidhatu. If asthi dhatu is healthy (sarvan) then its byproduct (malas) should develop healthy (prakrit). This topic is selected to study actual association of asthidhatu with kesh and nakha. It will helpful for treatment of disorders of hairs and nails.

METHODOLOGY

- 1) Detail study of hair (kesh), nails (nakha) & bones (asthi) is done in literature review.
- 2) 100 volunteers are selected randomly from campus of Ayurved college, Aurangabad.

Inclusion criteria

Age group -20 to 40

Healthy volunteers

Exclusion criteria

Age below 20 & above 40

Persons with any serious disease like tuberculosis, HIV, enteric fever etc.


3) *Sapta dhatu sarata* examination & examination of hair (*kesh*) and Nails (*nakha*) is done with the help of specially formed case paper.

Assessment of dhatu-sarata

- 1) If 75% lakshanas of dhatusarata are found then that dhatu is Uttamsaar.
- 2) If 50 74% lakshanas of dhatusarata are found then, that dhatu is Maddhyamsaar.
- 3) If less than 50% lakshanas are found then that dhatu is Hinasaar

a) Pie diagram showing % of prakrut & vikrut kesha & nakha in data of 100 volunteers




b) Comparison of % of disorders in male and female
