# CONCEPTUAL STUDY ON VIRECHANA KARMA BY TRIVRUT KALKA WITH KANJEE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF ARDHAVBHEDAKA VYADHI (MIGRAINE)

#### **ABSTRACT**

Ardhavbhedaka is an important and common disease. Vitiated Vata singly or accompanied by Kapha seizes the half of the head and then produces severe pain like cutting and churning in half of the Manya, Bhrukuti, Shankha Pradesh, Karna, Netra and Lalat. If far advanced, it may destroy the Netra and Karnaindriya. Due to these symptoms the patient becomes restless. Though the disease, Ardhavbhedaka is not a life threatening, it makes worried the patient and disturbing routine. It can be correlated with Migraine according to Modern system of medicine. Virechan is selected as a Kayavirechan in Ardhavbhedaka. Though it is Pittadosahar Chikitsa, also useful in Pittasaṃsruṣta Vata and Kapha. Means it is beneficial in Tridosa condition. For this study,

Trivrut Kalka with Kanjee is used as a Virechak Dravya. According to Acharya Charak Trivrut Kalka with any one of mentioned Dravya i.e. Amla Dravya, Gomutra, Mahish Mutra, Souvirak, Tushodak, Prasanna, Triphala Kwath etc. is used as a Virechan in Vatakaphaj Vikar. Trivrut is considered as Shreshtha Virechak Dravya and also it acts on Tridosha. Kanjee is Amla Rasatmak and having Teekshna property. It also acts as Bhedi according to Sushrut Acharya. As Ardhavbhedaka Vyadhi is Vatakaphaj according to Charak, the above mentioned Yoga will be effective.

#### INTRODUCTION

Ardhavbhedaka is an common disease described in Charak Samhita Siddhisthan 9/74-76. Vitiated Vata singly or accompanied by Kapha seizes the half of the head and then produces severe pain like cutting and churning in half of the Manya, Bhrukuti, Shankha Pradesh, Karna, Netra and Lalat. If far advanced, it may destroy the Netra and Karnaindriya. Due to these symptoms the patient becomes restless. Though the disease, Ardhavbhedaka is not a life threatening, it makes worried the patient and disturbing routine. It can be correlated with Migraine according to Modern system of medicine.

Migraine is a paroxysmal affection accompanied by severe headache, generally on one side of the head. It usually occurs when a person is under great mental tension or has suddenly got over that state. Migraine is also known as "sick headache" because nausea and vomiting occasionally accompany the excruciating pain which lasts for as long as three days. When the headache occurs, the patient may feel tingling, numbness, or weakness in an arm or leg.

In Chikitsa of Ardhavbhedak, Uttam Matra paan of Chatusneh, Shirovirechan, Kayavirechan, Nadisweda, Jeern Ghritpaan, Niruha Basti, Anuvasan Basti, Upanaha and Shirobasti are the treatment described by Acharya Charka.

Virechana, Nasya and Basti are the Panchakarma procedures useful for Ardhavbhedaka Vyadhi (Ch. Si. 9/77-78). Virechan is one of the type of Kayavirechan mentioned in Ardhavbhedaka. It is indicated in Shirashula also (Ch. Si. 2/13). For this study, Trivrut Kalka with Kanjee is used as a Virechak Dravya. According to Acharya Charak Trivrut Kalka with Amla Dravya -Kanjee (Ch. K. 7/12-13) is used as a Virechan in Vatakaphaj Vikar (Ch. K. 7/19).

**SAMPRAPTI** (**Pathogenesis**): The vata, getting provoked by consumption of dry articles or excess of diet or eating on a loaded stomach, exposure of eastern wind and frost, suppression of natural urges, excessive sexual indulgence, exertion and exercise, either alone or in combination with Kapha, seizes one half of head and causes acute neuralgic pain in the sides of the neck, eyebrow, temple, ear, eyes or forehead of one side. This pain is very agonizing like that of churning rod. This disease is called Ardhavabhedaka. If the condition becomes aggravated, it may even impasses the functions of the eye and ear.

#### **Chikitsa** (**Treatment**)

**Virechana Karma Review:** Elimination of Dosha through the Adhobhaga i.e. lower part of the body is Known as Virechana Karma.

Shodhananga Snehpana with Cow's ghrit for 3/5/7 days Arohana Kram till Samyak Snigdha Lakshanas were produced. Bahyasnehan and Sarvanga Bashpa Peti Swedana in last three days for accumulation of Doshas in Koshtha. These accumulated Doshas are removed from the body with the help of Virechana Karma. Virechana Karma acts not only on Pitta but also on Pittasaṃsruṣṭa Vata and Kapha. Hence the strotas gets purified.

#### **DISCUSSION**

1) Virechan Karma: Though it is Pittadosahar Chikitsa, also useful in Pittasaṃsruṣta Vata and Kapha. Means it is beneficial in Triḍoṣa condition. According to Charkacharya, in Ardhavbhedaka Vyadhi, Duṣti of Vata and Kapha takes place. Wheras Susrutacharya explains it as Tridosaj Vyadhi. Hence Virechan will act as a Shodhan Modality in Ardhavbhedaka Vyadhi.

#### 2) Virechana Drug

- ➤ Trivrut Kalka with Kanjee is used as a Virechak Dravya (Ch.K. 7/12-13) is used as a Virechan in Vatakaphaj Vikar (Ch.K. 7/19).
- ➤ Trivrut is considered as Shreshtha Virechak Dravya and also it acts on Tridosha (Ch.K. 7/6). It is having the properties of Lghu, Rukha and Teekshna. Because of these properties it removes the impurities from Sukshma Strotas. It is again mentioned as SukhaVirechak. So easily palatable for the patient.
- ➤ Kanjee is Amla Rasatmak and having Teekshna property. It also acts as Bhedi according to Sushrut Acharya (Su.Su.45/214-216).
- ➤ The Yog of Trivruta Kalka with Kanjee is mentioned in Vatakaphaj Vikara (Ch.K. 7/19). As Ardhavbhedaka Vyadhi is Vatakaphaj according to Charak, the above mentioned Yoga will be effective.
