In Ayurveda determined beauty by Prakriti (body constitution), Twak (skin completion), Praman (measurement), and Sahanana (compactness of body), Dirghayu (symptoms of long life). Mukhadushika is a type of Kshudraroga. This Doshas vitilation Vata, Kapha, Rakta and Shukra then having Shalmali like eruption on face. In Modern view Acne Vulgaris is compare with Mukhadushika. it is generally androgenic disease but today occurs due to imbalanced life style and heavy

pollutions. In Charaka Samhita, treatment of Mukhadushika is mentioned (Varnya, Kushtanga, Kandugna drugs are classified and some medicinal plants like Manjistha, Lodhra, Sariva, Dhanyaka and Masur dal etc.) and also important treatment in Ayurveda is Panchakarma. This includes in Snehana, Sweadana and Shodhana Karma are believed to be inhibiting trans-epidermal water loss and restoring cellular nutrition facilitating complete elimination and re-establishing balance of the Doshas.

INTRODUCTION

In Madhavnidana mentioned Mukhadushika in Kshudraroga. Mukhadushika is also known as Yuvanpidika. In younger age Kapha, Vata and Rakta Doshas Dushti produced and then Shalmali like eruptions are produce on face. Acharaya Vaghbhata says that Medadhatu also cause of Mukhadushika. This disease generally found in 16 -25 age, mostly found on face, forehead, chicks with symptoms itching, burning and also inflammation on face. In Ayurveda Panchakarma is the best treatment for Mukhadushika. the treatment follow in Mukhadushika is Lepa and Virechana Karma and also Shaman Chikitsa.

To evaluate the management of Mukhadushika.

DISCUSSION

Acharya Sushruta has mentioned Mukhadushika is a Kshudraroga. Most of the Acharaya supposed Kapha, Rakta as the causative for this disease while Acharya Bhavprakasha mention as a Svabhavaj, but the Sharangdhara said that this is a Shukra Dhatu Mala. The best treatment for the Mukhadushika is Virechana Shodhan Karma because Evacuation of the fecal matter and other accumulation of Dosha in the body is removed by Virechana Karma, the term Virechana is used to refer the elimination of Doshas the morbid accumulation of Pitta Doshas is best eliminated by this procedure and also abnormal accumulation of Kapha Dosha in the lower gastrointestinal tract and also Virechan Karma removes the Dosha Dushti because they maintain the body functions.

Lepa is the topical application of the herbal paste to the face and keeping it undisturbed for certain period is known as Mukhalepa. The paste prepared from Manjishta, Lodhra, Sariva and Masur Dal, Manjishta is useful in hyperpigmentation, increased skin complexion, antioxidant. Lodhra is anti-inflammatory and antiseptic. Sariva is anti-oxidant and anti-inflammatory.

CONCLUSION

In Mukhadushika as per reason along with Rasa Dhatu, Rakta Dhatu and Shukra Dhatu Dushti is possible. As Shukradhatu Dushti leads to increased Shukra Mala resulting in Mukhadushika then the Aapan Vayu Dushti can be maintained and stabilized the function with the help of Virechana Karma because to remove the Dosha Dushti and maintain the Shukradhatu function also maintain the Shukra Mala. Lepa works to improve the skin texture and fairness of skin.
