In ayurveda treatment there are different types of sthanik chikitsa mentioned in samhitas which is useful in strirog. Some of these are Yonidhavan, pichukalpna, kalkadharana, pinda, vartikalpna, yoniparisheka, yonidhupana, uttarbasti. This is conceptual study by this article I want to emphasize the importance of

yonidhavana in streerog. Yonidhavan local therapy mentioned in ayurveda is one of the safe and effective procedure for the women who are suffering from gynecological problem which are arises from poore hygien, illiteracy, poverty.

There are abhyantar and sthanik chikitsa explained by acharyas in ayurveda for different types of yoniroga and yonivyapada. Sthanik chikitsa means specific treatment given locally, It incude yonipichu (tampoons soaked in medicated oil or liquid placed into vagina), yonilepana (vaginal painting), uttarbasti (medicated oil or decoction is pushed in the vagina), yonidhupan (fumigation of vagina by medicated smoke), yonipuran (vaginal packing). Out of this yonidhavan is the one of the simple and gives excellent result if followed properly. In Yonipaicchilya Vat, Pimple, paris twak churna or Aragwadha twak decoction is useful for dhawan.<sup>[1]</sup>

By this article I want to emphasize literally view of yonidhavan, its importance and mode of action in streeroga which is mentioned in ayurveda under sthanik chikitsa.

# **Procedure of Yonidhavan**

- 1) Patient is advised to lie down in lithotomy position for procedure.
- 2) Vaginal part is cleaned with antiseptic solution.
- 3) Sterile rubber catheter can be inserted into vagina and vagina is washed out with decoction.
- 4) Vulva should be dried up with cotton after completion of procedure.
- 5) Procedure can be repeated as per requirements.
