#### **ABSTRACT**

Chapter of ear and hearing in Repertory of our homeopathic materia medica by James Tyler Kent gives us all the symptoms related to ear and hearing. #### **INTRODUCTION**

The ears serve two primary functions: hearing and balance.<sup>[1]</sup>

For hearing, sound waves travel through the ear canal and cause the tympanic membrane (eardrum) to vibrate. These vibrations are transmitted through three small bones in the middle ear, known as ossicles, which amplify and carry the sound waves to the inner ear. Inside the inner ear, specialized hair cells called stereocilia convert these vibrations into electrical signals.<sup>[1]</sup> These signals are then sent along nerve fibers to the brain, where they are interpreted as sound. In terms of balance, the inner ear contains semicircular canals filled with fluid and lined with hair-like sensors. When the head moves, the fluid in these canals

shifts, causing the sensors to bend.<sup>[2]</sup> This movement is detected by the sensors, which send signals through the vestibular nerve to the brain. The brain processes these signals to maintain balance and coordinate bodily movements. In summary, the ears are crucial for both hearing and maintaining balance, utilizing intricate mechanisms involving sound wave conversion to electrical signals for hearing, and fluid movement detection for balance. The ear is divided into three main parts: the outer ear, middle ear, and inner ear, each serving distinct functions in hearing and balance.<sup>[1,2]</sup>

**Outer ear:** The outer ear, also known as the external ear, includes the visible part of the ear called the auricle or pinna. This part is made of cartilage and skin, housing glands that produce earwax. Its funnel-shaped canal leads to the tympanic membrane, or eardrum, which separates the outer ear from the middle ear.<sup>[3]</sup>

**Middle ear:** The middle ear begins beyond the tympanic membrane and contains three small bones known as ossicles: the malleus, incus, and stapes. These ossicles transmit sound vibrations from the eardrum to the inner ear. The middle ear also includes the eustachian tubes, which help regulate air pressure within the ear.<sup>[3]</sup>

**Inner ear:** The inner ear comprises two main structures: the cochlea and the semicircular canals. The cochlea is responsible for hearing and is shaped like a snail shell. Inside the cochlea, sound waves are converted into electrical signals by hair cells that detect vibrations in fluid-filled chambers. These signals are then sent to the brain via the auditory nerve. The semicircular canals, part of the labyrinthine system, contribute to balance by detecting head movements and orientation. They send signals to the brain about the body's spatial position and movement.<sup>[2,3]</sup>

In summary, the outer ear gathers sound waves and directs them to the eardrum, where the middle ear's ossicles amplify and transmit these vibrations to the inner ear. There, the cochlea converts sound into nerve impulses for hearing, while the semicircular canals monitor head movements and help maintain balance.<sup>[3]</sup>

#### The most common ear diseases are

Ear infection (Otitis media), Eustachian tube dysfunction, Swimmer's ear (Otitis externa), Ruptured eardrum, Otosclerosis, Perichondritis, Vestibular neuritis, Meniere's disease, injury and trauma.<sup>[4]</sup>
