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# STUDY OF EFFICASY OF YAVA PRATISARNIYA KSHARA IN MANAGEMENT OF DUSHTA VRANA WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO CHRONIC INFECTED WOUND- A CASE STUDY

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#### **ABSTRACT**

Dushta vrana(infected wound) is common encountered problem faced in day to day surgical practice. Acharya Sushruta described 2 types of Vrana in Dvivraniya Chikitsa Adhyay of Shustrut Samhita Chikitsa Sthana. The 1) Nija Vrana and 2) Agantuj Vrana, both of these Vrana can convert into Dushta Vrana if not treated properly. Acharya Sushruta explained 60 types of Chikitsa Upakrma for management of Vrana Chikitsa. kshara pratisaran is one among it (39th Upakrana) A case of Dushta Vrana visited our institute is dignosed according to Shusrut Samhita and single setting of Yavakshar Pratisaran was done on Dushta Vrana followed by Nimbu Swaras Parishek and follow up by alternate day, dressing with normal saline upto wound heals

completely. The study shows *Vrana Shodhan* and *Ropan* properties of *Kshara* and shows The clinical features of *Dushta Vrana* is improved by end of week and wound is completely healed at 21<sup>st</sup> day. Follow up taken regularly upto 1 month shows no reccurence and with minimal scar. So the study shows *Kshar* can be used as effective and alternative management of *Dushta Vrana*.

#### INTRODUCTION

*Vrana* is seen debiliting and scaring disorder usually affecting human being at any age. *Vrana* is condition associated with *Dhatu nash* and characterized by *Vedna(pain)*,

Strava(discharge) and Sthanvikriti(deformality). Acharaya Shustruta in Chikitsasthan described 2 typers of *Vrana*.<sup>[1]</sup>

- 1)Nija vrana-which are caused by Dosha imbalance within body
- 2) Agantuj vrana-which are caused by external factors like injuries, bites, burns etc both this Vrana if not treated properly can convert into Dushta Vrana, which has signs of. [4]
- Putigandha(foul smell)
- Vividh strava( different types of discharge)
- Kandu(itching)
- Shotha(swelling)

Acharya Shustruta has described Shashti Upakrama(60 Types of treatment) for mangment of wound in Dvivraniyachikitsa Adhayay of Shusrut Samhita. [2] Among this Kshar Karma has described for wound of.<sup>[5]</sup>

- ➤ *Kathina vrana*(indurated)
- Kanduyukta(itching)
- > Chirotitha(chronic)
- Dukha sadhya(difficult to heal) Vrana

And again in Ksharpakvidhiadyay Shustruta advices application of Kshar in Dushta Vrana. [6] kshar karma has strong shodhan and Lekhan property so it could be a better option for vrana shodhan. The main aim of vrana shodhan is to remove dead tissue keeping the wound bed free from unwanted and harmful material.

According to clinical classification of wound it may be. [7]

- Healing
- Spreading
- Infected

Out of which infected wound has.

- 1) slough at floor
- 2) different types of discharge
- 3) chronicity

And treatment includes use of debridment/desloughing agents such as EUSOL, Hydrogen peroxide.<sup>[8]</sup>

Though they remove slough but can also hamper wound healing by disturbing normal tissue also.

And hence no longer recommended for infected wound<sup>[9]</sup>, so application of *Kshara* can be considerd as alternative management of *Dushta Vrana* as it has *Shodhana* property.

#### **CASE STUDY**

A 65 years old male patient having complaints of traumatic non healing wound since last 3 months at left leg near medial malleolus with.

- 1) Puya strav(pus discharge).
- 2) Putigandha(foul smell).
- 3) Kandu (itching).
- 4) *Shopha* and *Kathinya*(inflammation and induration at edges).
- 5) Chirotitha vrana(chronic wound) as patient having wound more than 3 months.

He took treatment in many hospital but not get relief so after examing his wound and systemic and lab investigations patient is descided to took for *Yava Kshara Pratisarana* for his *Dushta Vrana*.

### Lab Investigation

- 1) HB-11.5% gm/dl
- 2) BSL®-86 mg/dl
- 3) B.T-2.10/min
- 4) C.T-3.42/min
- 5) S.creatine-1.21 mg/dl
- 6) HIV and HBSAG-non reative

#### MATERIALS AND METHODS

Yava Kshara, Gauze, Pads, Nimbu Swaras

- A singal setting of *Yava Kshara* with *Nakhausedh Matra* amount is applied over wound at left foot near medial mellaolus for period of 100 *Vakmatra*.<sup>[10]</sup>
- -After that *Parishek* of *Nimbu Swaras* is done at wound site.
- -After that dressing done on each alternative day with normal saline till wound heals.

#### RESULTS

The clinical features of *Dushta Vrana* is improved by end of week and wound is completely healed at 21<sup>st</sup> day with minimal scar formation. Follow up is taken for 1 month and no reccurence is observed.



#### **DISCCUSSION**

Above case study demonstrate the debriding properties of Yava Kshara. Yava Kshar presents high efficacy in *Vrana Shodhana* and *Vrana Ropana* and heal wound with minimal scar without any adverse effects. The local application of *yava kshar* reduces excessive exudates and necrotic tissues, it also reduces local discharge and facilitates granulation tissue formation which is necessary for wound healing. All of which helps in faster healing of wounds.

## **CONCLUSION**

On the basis of above case study it can be concluded that local application of *Yava Kshara* was found to be very effective in management of *Dushta Vrana*. Thus can be used as alternative approach for management of *Dushta Vrana*.

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
