KASISADI CHURNA IN AYURVEDA: LITERARY REVIEW

ABSTRACT

Drug is the important tool of a physician. The word drug has been defined as any substance used for diagnosis, prevention and relief or cure of disease in man or animals. All Dravya are Panchbhautika in the world and body is also Panchbhautika. So there is no Dravya which can not be used as medicines and administration of any substance or mixture of substances depends upon the Yukti of Vaidya. In Classics, a lot of single as well as compound drugs are described in various contexts for internal as well as external use. Kasisadi Churna And Churna (4,7,9) is a compound drugs (Herbal and Mineral drugs) and used with Madhu internally in form of Churna. Their actions have been explained on the basis of their Rasa, Guna, Veerya, Vipaka and Prabhav. Charaka Vagbhata (Ashtanga Hridaya and Ashtanga Sangraha), Bhaisajya

Ratnavali^[15], Yoga Ratnakara^[27] have mentioned same 'Chikitsa –Siddhanta' in Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad is 'Ruksha and Ushna Chikitsa'. Kasisadi Churna with Madhu Anupana follow same 'Ruksha and Ushna Chikitsa – Siddhanta'. So Kasisadi Churna with Madhu Anupana^[4,7,9] orally is beneficial in Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad. Hence, study effort has been put forth to make a literary study covering almost all aspects of Kasisadi Churna as per Ayurveda.

INTRODUCTION

प्रयोजनं चास्य स्वस्थस्य स्वास्थ्यरक्षणमातुरस्य विकारप्रशमनं च ॥ २६ ॥ (च.सू. ३०)

The two main goals of Ayurveda are – To protect the health of healthy person to eradicate the disease. ^[2] These two goals will be achieved with the help of Dravya.

According to W.H.O., A drug is a substance or product that is used to modify or explore physiological systems or pathological states, for the benefit of the recipient. Drug is integral component of Trisutra^[1] (Hetu, Linga and Aushadh). 'Dhatu – Samya'^[1] the sole motto of treatment in Ayurveda is achieved by proper usage of Drug and it adds move active functional years to total human life by its preventive, promative and curative effects.

Ayurvedic Dravya (Drug or medicine) is based on the idea that the world is made up of five elements – Aakash (Space), Vayu (Air), Agni (Fire), Jala (Water) and Prithvi (Earth). [3]

Ayurvedic literature contains infinite number of herbs. Their actions have been explained on the basis of their Rasa, Guna, Veerya, Vipaka and Prabhav. [16,17,22]

Kasisadi Churna is a combination of Herbo – mineral drugs. Acharya Vagbhata has mentioned Kasisadi Churna (Kasis, Kankshi, Triphala, Amrasthi, Jambavasthi and Dhataki Churna) with Madhu Anupana orally and this drug is useful specially in Paicchilaya Yoni of Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad.^[7,9]

Acharya Charaka also has mentioned Kasisadi Churna with Madhu same as Acharya Vagbhata but one change is that Samanga^[4] (lajjalu) Churna is taken in place of Jambavasthi.

According to Acharya Charaka, Lakshan of Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad is Picchilam, Sheetam, Kandugrasthaam, Alpavedanaam along with Panduvarnata and Pandupicchil artava. [11,4] Acharya Sushruta has mentioned Picchila Yoni (Vaginal discharge) along with Yoni Kandu (itching in vulva and vagina) and Atisheetala. [5] Acharya Vagbhata has mentioned Yoni – Avedana along with lakshanas same as Acharya Charaka. [6] All Acharya has mentioned same 'Chikitsa – Siddhanta' in Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad is 'Ruksha and Ushna Chikitsa'. [4,9,7,27,15]. Kasisadi Churna with Madhu cures Kaphaj yoni vyapad (Pruritus vulvae). [12] According to Acharya Vagbhata and Acharya Charaka, Kasisadi Churna with Madhu is useful specially in Paicchilaya Yoni of Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad. [4,7,9]

So in this study an effort has been put forth to make a conceptual study covering almost all the aspects of Kasisadi Churna.

AIM AND OBJECTIVE

To study about the literary review of Kasisadi Churna.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

This conceptual study is made after reviewing all the available Ayurvedic classics as well as modern books thoroughly.

DESCRIPTION

KASISADI CHURNA

Kasis, Kankshi (Acharya Charaka and Acharya Vagbhata according). [20,21,23,25,26]



- Haritaki is Rasayana, Tridoshahara, Krimighna, Kaphaghna, Vrushya, Garbhasaya -Sothahara, Prajasthapana, Antimicrobial, Antifungal, Antibacterial, Anti stress, Hypotensive.
- Amalaki is Tridoshahara, Alpa Stambhanakari, Kaphaghna, Vrushya, Garbha -Mutrala, Deepaniya, Anulomaniya, Antimicrobial, Antioxidant, Sthapana, Antibacterial, Anti fungal, Anti ulcer.
- Bibhitaki is Tridoshahara, Deepaniya, Anulomaniya, Vedana Sthapana, Krimighna, Kaphahara, Antibacterial, Antifungal, Antistress and Blood pressure depressant.
- Amrasthi (Beej- Majja) is Kapha-Pitta Shamaka, Rakta rodhaka, Vrana ropana, Stambhana, Krimighna, Garbhashaya – sothahara, Mutra – sangrahaniya and internally useful in Atisara, Pravahika, Krimi, Raktapitta, Rakta - pradara, Sweta - pradara, Prameha, Puyameha and Antiseptic, Hypertension, Diuretic.

Jambavasthi is Kapha – Shamaka (due to Ruksha Guna, Kashaya Rasa), Pitta – Shamaka (due to Sheeta Veerya, Kashaya Rasa), Vata – Vardhaka (due to Ruksha – Sheeta Kashaya), Stambhanakara, Twaka-doshahara, Daha – prashamana and Useful in Kapha – Paittika Vikara.

Beej – Majja Churna is also beneficial in Jeerna – Atisara, Pravahika, Rakta – Pradara, Raktatisara and used as a best medicine in Madhumeha and Udakmeha. PittaKaphashamaka, Antiviral, Neuropsychological, Antifertility, Anorexigemic, Anti inflammatory.

- Dhataki is Daha prashamana, Rakta stambhana, Jantughna, Vrana ropana,
 Stambhana, Sandhaniya, Raktapitta shamaka, Mutra virajniya, Kusthaghna, Jwaraghna
 and cures different types of Yoni Srava (Vaginal discharges), Kaphapittahara,
 Vishaghna, Krimighna, Garbhasthapana, Antibiotic, Antifungal, Antiviral.
- Samanga is Kaphapitta shamaka, Sandhaniya, Rakta- Stambhana, Vrana ropana,
 Stambhana, Vishaghna, Raktapitta shamaka, Rakta shodhaka, Shothahara.
- Kasis is Kandughna, Vishaghna, Mutrakricchahara, Ashmarihara, Svitra nashak, Kshayaghna, Vranaghna, Pandu nashak, Jvaraghna, Pleeha – roga nashak, Gudabhransha, Visarpa nashak, VataKaphahara, Mutrala and its regular administration improves the haemoglobin percentage in the blood.
 - Kasis Bhasma is a clinically proven cure for anemia, liver disorders and spleen enlargement. Kasis Bhasma also eliminates toxins from the body thus rejuvenating the liver and spleen. - Kankshi is Vranaghna, Vishaghna, Svitra, Kustha nashak, Tridoshaja, Gara Vishanashak and cures Kaphaj Roga, Netra roga, Urah Kshata, Kshaya, Shula, Visarpa, Visham Jvara, Pittaj roga, Kandughna, Astringent / Styptic, Anti-inflammatory, a Good healer of wounds and Antiseptic.
- Madhu is Tridosha Shamaka (According to Acharya Sushruta), Kapha Shamaka, Vata
 Vardhaka (According to Acharya Charaka), Cchedana, Raktapitta hara, Yogavahi,
 Vishaghna, Mehaghna, Kushthaghna, Krimighna, Chardighna, Shwasaghna, Kasaghna,
 Vrana -shodhana, Vrana sandhana, Vrana ropana, Lekhana Karma, Kaphasoshana Guna
 Karma, Vatakaphahara and Antibacterial, Worm infestation, Antimicrobial, Excellent
 Wound healer. Madhu is a great source of anti oxidant that strengthens the immune
 system.

DISCUSSION

There is no Dravya which can not be used as medicines and administration of any substance or mixture of substances depends upon the Yukti of Vaidya. [3] Kasisadi Churna is a combination of Herbo – Mineral drugs which are having properties of Tridoshahara, Rasayana, Kaphaghna, Krimighna, Kandughna, Vishaghna, Netrya, Keshya, Shulaghna, Roga-nashak, Rakta sravarodhaka, Yoni sankochaka, VataKaphahara, PittaKapha-Shamak, Garbhashaya Sothahara, Garbhasthapana, Lekhana Karma, Kaphasoshan Guna Karma and Sthambhana Guna Karma etc. and have Anti fungal, Anti bacterial, Anti microbial, Anti viral, Anti septic, Anti ulcer, Anti fertility, Diuretic, Antibiotic, Neuropsychological, Worm infestation property and action. Madhu is taken as Anupana with Kasisadi Churna which have Ushna Veerya and Ruksha Guna act as Lekhana Karma, Kaphasoshana Guna Karma and VataKaphahara. Hence, Kasisadi Churna with Madhu Anupana plays important role in Kaphaj yoni vyapad (Pruritus Vulvae)^[12] lakshana like Picchila Yoni (Vaginal discharge), Yoni Kandu (Itching in Vulva and Vagina) and Yoni Sheetala. [12, 6]

CONCLUSION

Most of the drugs (herbal and mineral drugs) in Kasisadi Churna is Laghu, Ruksha Guna, Kashaya Rasa and Ushna Veerya and Madhu is also Kashaya Rasa, Laghu, Ruksha Guna and Ushna Veerya. Kapha – Soshana Guna Karma is due to Kashaya Rasa, Ruksha Guna and VataKaphahara is due to Ushna Veerya. All Acharya has mentioned same 'Chikitsa – Siddhanta' in Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad is 'Ruksha and Ushna Chikitsa'. So Kasisadi Churna with Madhu Anupana follow same 'Ruksha and Ushna Chikitsa – Siddhanta'. According to Acharya Vagbhata and Acharya Charaka, Kasisadi Churna with Madhu is useful specially in Paicchilaya Yoni of Kaphaj Yoni Vyapad. [4,7,9,11]
