Allergic Rhinitis can be defined as it's a hypersensitivity reaction by mucosa of nose in response to allergen and presented with episodic attacks of sneezing, watery nasal discharge and epiphora.^[2]

Causes

Causative factors for Allergic Rhinitis are as follows^[4,5],

- 1. Age: In any age of person can be suffer from Allergic rhinitis.
- 2. Sex: Male are more commonly affected to allergic rhinitis, ratio of affection male: female is about 3:2
- 3. Industrialization: Allergic rhinitis get more aggravated with exposure to pollution.
- 4. Hereditary: It plays important role in manifestation of allergic rhinitis. There will be more chance in child if one or both parents suffered from allergic rhinitis.
- 5. IgA deficiency- this type of patient more prone to allergic rhinitis
- 6. Living conditions: Residential plays important role in occurrence of Allergic rhinitis. If room with dusty environment, less ventilated and with A.C. are more responsible for trigger of allergic rhinitis.
- 7. Irritant: Smoke and fumes.

- 2. Medicinal treatment:
- Anti-histaminic- To relives symptoms by decreasing in secretions.
- Corticosteroid Act against inflammation of nasal mucosa.
- 3. Surgical treatment:
- Correction of DNS.
- Vidian neurectomy.
- Removal of septic foci by dental eradication, tonsillectomy.
- 4. Immunotherapy


Types

According to Acharya Shushruta *Vata, pitta, kapha dosha and Rakta* get imbalanced due to *Tridoshadushti Hetus* then it *Prakupita Dosha* get accumulated in *Shirapradesh* that is head and nasal cavity and Pratishyaya occurs.^[9]

As per Acharya Charaka rupa of Vataj Pratishyaya are as follows^[10],

- Ghranarti Toda Sensation of pricking in nose
- *Kshwathu* Excessive Sneezing
- Jalambastrav Rhinorrhea
- Swarabheda Change in voice
- Shirashool Headache
