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ROLE OF RAKTAVAHA SROTODUSHTI HETU IN VYANGA WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO MELASMA

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ABSTRACT

Ayurveda is one of the oldest sciences known to mankind and its literal translation means "the science of life". There are various diseases and its prevention, management available in Ayurveda science. Knowledge of Srotas is very important in every disorder in its diagnosis, prevention as well as management. In Vyanga there is Dushti of Raktavaha Srotas. Acharya Charaka has explained Raktavaha Srotodushti Hetu and its Dushti Lakshanas along with its treatment. Therefore, we need to understand the importance of Srotodushti Hetu and Lakshanas in disorders. In this article finding the role of Raktavaha Srotodushti Hetu in the disease Vyanga with special reference to Melasma.

INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is a holistic approach to health and focuses on maintaining a

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physically and emotionally Balanced state.^[1] The principle of *Ayurveda* is to protect the health of the healthy and to alleviate disorders in the diseased.^[2] '*Vyanga*' is one of the most common disease which is related to our facial skin. In *Ayurveda*, '*Vyanga*' is counted as *Kshudraroga*^[3] & also mention in *Raktavaha stroto dushti lakshane*.

Vyanga is one of the skin disorder, it involves vitiation of Vata, Pitta, Rakta and Manasika Nidanas like Krodha, Shoka etc. It has cardinal features like Niruja, Tanu, Shyavavrana Mandalas. In the management of Vyanga, there is Shodhana and Shamana Chikitsa explained in the form of Raktamokshana, Lepa, etc.

Raktavaha stroto dushti hetu^[4] is mentioned in Vimanasthana of Charaka Samhita. It includes intake of substances which has oily contents, which produces burning sensation inside the body, excessive intake of food, etc. are the vitiating causative factors for Raktavaha Srotodushti Hetu.

METHODOLOGY

Raktavaha srotodushti hetu

The following are the *Dushti Nidana* for the *Raktavaha Srotas* Vitiation; Excessive intake of following leads to Vitiation of *Raktavaha Srotas*;

- ✓ *Vidahi Annapana* [Food which causes burning sensation]
- ✓ Snigdha Aahara
- ✓ Ushna Aahara
- ✓ Drava Aahara
- ✓ Exposure to *Aatapa* [Sunlight] and *Anila* [Air]

Vyanga review

Nidana of vyanga

The causative factors for the *Vyanga*, according to the *Acharya Sushruta*, *Aayasa*, *Krodha*, *Shoka*, and *Shrama* are mentioned as Aggravating factors for the *Vyanga*. [5]

Following are the aggravating factors or causative factors for the *Vyanga Vyadhi*.

Poorvarupa

There are no Poorvarupas are mentioned in the Samhitas regarding Vyanga.

Roopa

When *Dosha-Dushya Sammurcchana* occurs in the *Vyadhi*, then specific signs and symptoms are produced which are known as '*Roopa*' of the *Vyadhi*.

The Roopas mentioned by Acharyas; are as follows

Clinical types & Lakshana of Vyanga

According to the pre-dominancy of the *Dosha*, the Disease *Vyanga* can be categorized into four sub-types which are as follows;

Samprapti

There are various Sampraptis are mentioned in the classics, which are as follows

- According to *charaka*: The aggravated *Pitta* gets dried up in the combination with *Rakta* and produces the disease *Vyanga*. [11]
- ❖ According to *sushruta*: The anger and exhaustion causes vitiation of *Vata* and *Pitta*. The vitiated *doshas* reaches the face and produces *Niruja*, *Tanu* and *Shyava varnayukta*

mandalas. These mandalas are called as Vyanga. In this disease the Shyava varnayukta are mainly due to the predominance of Vata dosha. [12]

❖ According to *Vagbhata*: *Vata* and *pitta* gets aggravated by *shoka*, *krodha* etc produces thin, blackish, round patches on the face to be termed as *Vynaga*. [13]

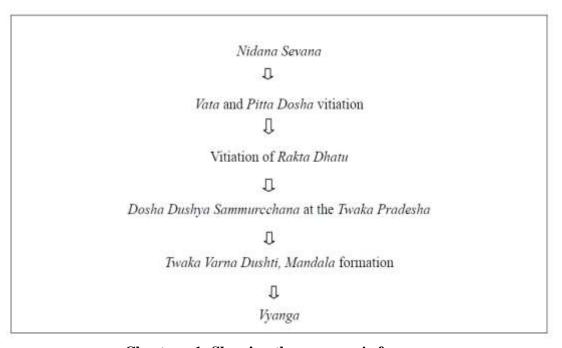


Chart no. 1: Showing the samprapti of vyanga.

Review on melasma^[14]

Melasma also called as 'Chloasma', it appears as asymmetrical blotchy brownish pigmentation on the face. This pigmentation is due to the overproduction of melanin by the pigment cells – melanocytes. It can lead to considerable embarrassment and distress.

The cause for the melasma is complex. There is a genetic predisposition to melasma, with at least one – third of patient reporting other family members to be affected. In most of the people melasma is a chronic disorder.

Role of raktavaha srotodushti hetu in vyanga

Raktavaha Stroto Dushti Hetu mentioned in various factors as per various Acharyas. Vyanga is one of among the Kshudrakushtha. So specific Nidana Poorvarupa etc. are not mentioned for Vyanga but as per Raktavaha Stroto Dushti Hetus are considered as causative factors for the development of Vyanga.

In Kushtha Vyadhi there is vitiation of Raktadi Dosha Dushyas. Also, Kushtha described among the Raktapradoshaja Vyadhi. Due to their Ashraya Ashrayi Sambandha it vitiates Pitta Dosha as well as Rakta Dushya. So, there is important to know the Nidana of Raktapradoshaja Vyadhi and Raktavaha Stroto Dushti Hetu while dealing with the Kushtha Vyadhi.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

The *Vyadhi Vyanga* is one of the *Kshudraroga* and also mentioned in the *Raktavaha Stroto Dushti Lakshanas*. Various Creams, lotions, beauty products were available for the management of *Vyanga* i.e. Melasma. In *Ayurveda*, there are various managements are described for *Vyanga* but main *Chikitsa* is *Nidana Parivarjana*, which helps to reduces the signs and symptoms of *Vyanga* by avoiding its causative factors. *Rakta* is one of the main causative factor which is related with the *Raktavaha Stroto Dushti*. *Vyanga* is also mentioned among the *Raktavaha Stroto Dushti Lakshana* and *Vyadhi*. Therefore, its causative factors are important for the proper diagnosis and management of disease *Vyanga*.

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
