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# KURANTAKA (BARLERIA PRIONITIS LINN) A DRUG REVIEW FROM NIGHANTU KAAL

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#### **ABSTRACT**

The term *Nighantu* depends on the term *Nigama*. The historical underpinnings of *Nigama* is, which brings out the incredibly covered or secret significance of words in fundamental way. The *Nighantu* writing is one of the significant angles in the investigation of Ayurveda and uniquely in the subject of *Dravyaguna Vijnana*. The *Nighantu* writing is likewise pretty much as old as Ayurveda. Much significance has not been given to the investigation of *Nighantu*. As *Niganthu's* have all details of *Guna*, *karma*, *Rasa virya vipak* as well as synonym information in them it becomes very easy to study medicinal plant in detail. So in current study references of *Kurantaka* (*Barleria Prionitis Linn.*) collected from various *Niganthu's*. *Kurantaka* is mentioned as

one of type of *Saireyaka*. Four Varieties of *Saireyaka Rakta*, *Peeta*, *Neela*, *Sweta* are mentioned in *Niganthu's*. *Peeta Saireyaka* as *Kurantaka* mentioned in *Bhavprakash Nighantum*, *Dhanvantari Nighant*, *Kaiyadeva Nighantu*, *Madanpal Nighantu*, *Nighantu shesha*, *Raj Nighantu* etc. *Kurantaka* (*Barleria prionitis* linn) is easily available throughout India hence chosen for study.

Prior *Nighantus* were restricted to clarify the equivalents as it were. The *Nighantu* writing is one of the significant angles in the investigation of Ayurveda and uniquely in the subject of *Dravyaguna Vijnana*. *Kurantaka* is mentioned as one of type of *Saireyaka*. Four Varieties of *Saireyaka Rakta*, *Peeta*, *Neela*, *Sweta* are mentioned in *Niganthu's*.

Peeta Saireyaka as Kurantaka mentioned in Bhavprakash Nighantum<sup>[1]</sup>, Dhanvantari Nighantu<sup>[2]</sup>, Kaiyadeva Nighantu<sup>[3]</sup>, Madanpal Nighantu<sup>[4]</sup>, Nighantu shisha<sup>[18]</sup>, Raj Nighantu<sup>[6]</sup> etc.

Kurantaka (Barleria prionitis linn) is easily available throughout India hence chosen for study. [27]

#### Niganthu kala

#### Abhidhaan manjiri<sup>[11]</sup>

No direct reference of found about *peet* verity *Sahachar / Kurantaka*, although *Sahachar* synonyms and *Shweta*, *Neela* verity mentioned.

#### Abhidhaan ratnamala<sup>[12]</sup>

Nighantu mentions about Peeta Saireyaka as Kurantaka in Tikita skandha, other two varities of Saireyaka also mentioned Neela and Aruna.

#### Ashtang Nightanu<sup>[13]</sup>

No direct reference of *Kurantaka /Peeta Saireyaka* is found, it mentiones about *Neela* verity of *Saireyaka*.

#### Bhavprakash Niganthu<sup>[3]</sup>

Bhavprakash mentions Kurantaka should be always taken in wet form is Aushadh graham rules, And in Kurantaka is name given to Peeta Saireyaka and other verities of Saireyaka like Sweta, Rakta, Neela are also mentioned by Bhavprakash. It is said to have madhur-tika rasa and ushna veerya, Guna Snidha and kesharanjaan is also karma mentioned by Bhavprakash.

## Chamatkaar Nighantu<sup>[14]</sup>

No reference found abou Saireyaka/sahachaar/Kurantaka in Chamatkaar Nighantu.

## Dravyaguna Samgraha<sup>[15]</sup>

No reference found in Chakrapanidatta's Dravya guna samgraha about Saireyaka.

### Dhanvantari Nighantu<sup>[2]</sup>

In *Guduchyadi varga* three types of *Saireyaka* are mentioned accourding to flowers - *Peeta*, *Rakta*, *Neela*. *Peeta* is mentioned as *Kurantaka* and *Rakta* is mentioned as *Kurabaka*. *Dhanvantari Nighantu* specially mentions guna karma of *Kurantaka* as *Hima veerya*, *Tikta* 

rasa and having action as "Tri doshashamak". Shopha-Daha-Trushna hara, Vrushya and keshya as well.

## Kaiyadev Nighantu<sup>[3]</sup>

Mentions about all four verity of *Saireyaka*, Out of which *Peeta pushpa* is said as *Kurantaka*, *Balas-vaat* and *Rakta*, *kushtha kandu*, *visha* are mentioned in *guna karma* of *Saireyaka*.

## Madanpal Nighantu<sup>[4]</sup>

*Mrudukantak* is the different synonym given. *Kurantaka* mentioned as *Peeta Saireyaka*. other varities like *Rakta* and *Neela* are also mentioned.

## Madanadi Nighantu<sup>16]</sup>

In *Chaturdasha gana*, *Saireyaka* is mentioned. Different synonyms of *Saireyaka* are mentioned. Specification of *Kurantaka / Peet* varity not found.

#### Raj Nighantu<sup>[6]</sup>

Raj Nighantu mentioned in Karviradi varga. Seven synonyms of Kurantaka are mentioned. Like Kinkirat, Peetaamlan, Kurantaka, kanaka, Peeta kurava, Supeeta, Peetakusuma. Rasa are mentioned as Kashya-Tikta. Virya as Ushna virya and said to have Vaat-Kaphajeet action.

## Naam Samgraha<sup>[17]</sup>

In *Guguchaydi varga* different varieties of *Saireyaka* are mentioned. Four types are mentioned accounding to color's of flowers. Variety with *Peeta* flowers is accepted as *Kurantaka*.

## Nighantu shisha<sup>[18]</sup>

Mentions about three verity of *Saireyaka*. Name specification mentioned. *Kurantaka* mentioned as *Peeta* pusha, *Rakta* as *artagala* and *Neela* as *Bana/dasi/Audakya*.

### Paryayaratnamala<sup>[25]</sup>

Paryaya ratna mala mentions Vira, Sahachar, Peetapushpa, Dasi as synonyms of Kurantaka.

## Saraswati Nighantu<sup>[20]</sup>

Sahachar mentioned in Kshupa varga. Kurantaka is name mentioned along with Kurabak and Zhiniti.

## Shabdachandrika<sup>[7]</sup>

In Vrukshadi *varga* two types of *Sahachar* (*Sahachar* i-dwaya) are mentioned *Peeta* and *Neela*. *Peeta* is mentioned as Kurantak.

## Shodhal Nighantu<sup>[26]</sup>

Four types of Saireyaka are mentioned in Guduchyadi varga. Peeta is accepted as Kurantaka.

### Shaligram Nighantu<sup>[9]</sup>

Peeta verity mentioned as Kurantaka. Guna-karma's of Kurantaka are mentioned.

## Soushruta Nighantu<sup>[22]</sup>

Different synonyms are mentioned of Saireyaka in Araghvadhadi gana.

#### **DISCUSSION**

In *Abhidhaan manjiri* no direct reference of found about *peet* verity *Sahachar / Kurantaka*, although *Sahachar* synonyms and *Shweta*, *Neela* verity's are mentioned. *Abhidhaan ratnamala Nighantu* mentions about *Peeta Saireyaka* as *Kurantaka* in *Tikita skandha*, other two varities of *Saireyaka* also mentioned *Neela* and *Aruna*.

Ashtang Nightanu no direct reference of Kurantaka / Peeta Saireyaka is found, it mentiones about Neela verity of Saireyaka.

In Bhavprakash Niganthu Bhavprakash mentions Kurantaka should be always taken in wet form as Aushadh graham rules. Kurantaka name given to Peeta Saireyaka and other verities of Saireyaka like Sweta, Rakta, Neela are also mentioned by Bhavprakash. It is said to have madhur-tika rasa and Ushna veerya, Guna Snidha and kesharanjaan is also karma mentioned by Bhavprakash. Whereas no reference found about Saireyaka / Sahachaar/Kurantaka in Chamatkaar Nighantu as well as in Chakrapanidatta's Dravyaguna Samgraha.

References in *Dhanvantari Nighantu*, in *Guduchyadi varga* three types of *Saireyaka* are mentioned accourding to flowers *Peeta*, *Rakta*, *Neela*. *Peeta* is mentioned as *Kurantaka* and *Rakta* is mentioned as *Kurabaka*. *Dhanvantari Nighantu* specially mentions *guna karma* of *Kurantaka* as *Hima veerya*, *Tikta rasa* and having action as "*Tri doshashamak*". *Shopha-Daha-Trushna hara*, *Vrushya* and *keshya* as well.

Kaiyadev Nighantu also mentions about all four verity of Saireyaka, Out of which Peeta pushpa is said as Kurantaka, Balas-vaat and Rakta, kushtha kandu, visha are mentioned in guna karma of Saireyaka. In Madanpal Nighantu, Mrudukantak is a different synonym given. Kurantaka mentioned as Peeta Saireyaka, other varities like Rakta and Neela are also mentioned. Saireyaka is mentioned in Madanadi Nighantu in Chaturdasha gana. Different synonyms of Saireyaka are mentioned. Specification of Kurantaka / Peet varity not found.

In Raj Nighantu it's mentioned in Karviradi varga. Seven synonyms of Kurantaka are mentioned like Kinkirat, Peetaamlan, Kurantaka, kanaka, Peeta kurava, Supeeta, Peetakusuma. Rasa are mentioned as Kashya-Tikta. Virya as Ushna virya and said to have Vaat-Kaphajeet action. In Naam Samgraha in Guguchaydi varga different varieties of Saireyaka are mentioned. Four types are mentioned accourding to color's of flowers. Variety with Peeta flowers is accepted as Kurantaka.

Nighantu shesha mentions about three verity of Saireyaka.Name specification mentioned. Kurantaka mentioned as Peeta pusha, Rakta as artagala and Neela as Bana/dasi/Audakya.

Paryayaratnamala mentions Vira, Sahachar, Peetapushpa, Dasi as synonyms of Kurantaka.

In Saraswati Nighantu, Sahachar mentioned in Kshupa varga. Kurantaka is name mentioned along with Kurabak and Zhiniti. In Shabdachandrika in Vrukshadi varga two types of Sahachar (Sahachari-dwaya) are mentioned Peeta and Neela. Peeta is mentioned as Kurantak.

Four types of *Saireyaka* are mentioned in Guduchyadi *varga in Shodhal Nighantu and Peeta* is accepted as *Kurantaka*. *Shaligram Nighantu* also mentions *Peeta* verity as *Kurantaka*. Guna-karma's of *Kurantaka* are also mentioned.

In Soushruta Nighantu Different synonyms are mentioned of Saireyaka in Araghvadhadi gana.

#### CONCLUSION

*Kurantaka* available throughout India should be used widely in Clinical practice. Majority of *Kurantaka* references found in *Nighantu* include it's use in *Kandu, Kushta, Twak dosha,*. *Rakta vikaar etc* so in dermatological practice Barleria Prionitis Linn it should be used or dermatological clinical or pre-clinical trials can be also conducted.

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
